

Wolfville & Acadia University Visitors' Map



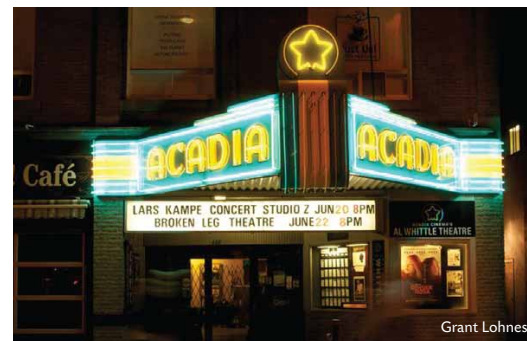
Downtown Wolfville
